Sign-in

A player is required to produce his/her Passport or National ID to verify their Date of Birth and Nationality.

- On-line (preferred)

Online sign-in for Qualifying is available for entered players on the Qualifying Acceptance list. The online sign-in opens 24 hours before the Qualifying sign-in deadline and closes at the Qualifying sign-in deadline (18.00 local time the day before start of the Qualifying event).

- By phone call (only voice call, not message text or email)

Players on the Qualifying Acceptance list or the Alternates list can sign-in by calling the Supervisor by phone.

Players on the Qualifying Acceptance List who wish to Preserve Eligibility for the Main Draw must always contact the Supervisor by phone. Preserving Eligibility is not available from the online system.

Players Applying for Special Exempt must do so by contacting the Supervisor of their 'current' tournament who will get in contact with the Supervisor. Applying for Special Exempt status is not available from the online system.

Coaches signing-in for a group of players are recommended to call the Supervisor by phone. The online system is only available for individual sign-ins.

The telephone sign-in opens latest at 15.00 and closes at 18.00 local time the day before the start of the Qualifying.

- On site

Players who appear on the Singles Qualifying Acceptance list at the time of the Freeze Deadline are committed to play in the Qualifying event and to sign-in in person with the Supervisor before 18.00 hours local time on the day before start of the Qualifying event. The Qualifying sign-in Deadline shall open at least two (2) hours earlier.

Alternate list and On-site Alternates

Can sign-in by phone or on-site.

Wild Card Qualies

Wild Cards are not required to sign-in, but **must reconfirm their participation by contacting the Supervisor before the Qualifying Sign-in Deadline.**

Sign-in

Players who signed-in for Qualifying and were then successfully moved to the Main Draw list do not have to sign-in again.

- On-line (preferred)

Online sign-in for Main Draw is available for entered players on the Main Draw Acceptance list.

The online sign-in opens 24 hours before the Main Draw sign-in deadline and closes at the Main Draw sign-in deadline (18.00 local time the day before start of the Main Draw event).

- By phone call (only voice call, not message text or email)

Players on the Main Draw Acceptance list can sign-in by calling the Supervisor by phone. Coaches signing-in for a group of players are recommended to call the Supervisor by phone. The online system is only available for individual sign-ins.

The telephone sign-in opens latest at 15.00 and closes at 18.00 local time the day before the start of the Main Draw.

- On site

Entered players who appear on the Singles Main Draw Acceptance list at the time of the Freeze Deadline are committed to play in the Singles Main Draw event and to **sign-in in person with the Supervisor before 18.00 hours local time on the day before start of the Singles Main Draw event. The Main Draw sign-in Deadline shall open at least two (2) hours earlier.**

Wild Cards

Main Draw Wild Cards are not required to sign-in, but **must reconfirm their participation by contacting the Supervisor before the Main Draw Sign-in Deadline.**

Players should voluntarily pay their entry upon arrival at the Tournament site. Players not having paid their entry or paid/renewed the IPIN membership fee online before first match will not be accepted to play.

Lucky Losers

On the day of the completion of the Qualifying, all players who lost in the last round of Qualifying will be considered for a Lucky Loser position. Therefore, **it is the player's responsibility to inform the Tennis Europe Supervisor by the end of the Qualifying if they do not want to be considered for a Lucky Loser position.**

On subsequent days Lucky Losers **must be present and sign-in with the Tennis Europe Supervisor at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start of play, to be eligible as Lucky Losers.**

The order so established is also used for the Lucky Loser Sign-in lists used on the first day(s) of the Main Draw as long as there are still players to play their first match, whether this is in the first round or subsequent rounds. For such days, the Lucky Loser Sign-in closes 30 minutes before the scheduled start of play in the event and shall open at least 30 minutes before.

Once called, a Lucky Loser must be ready to play within five (5) minutes. If a Lucky Loser is called to play but is not ready within five (5) minutes, the player will be moved to the bottom of the Lucky Loser list for that day, but will keep his/her original position on the list for any further days.

• Double Draw (24 players)

From Monday, March 04 to Saturday, March 09

Sign-in

A player is required to produce his/her Passport or National ID to verify their Date of Birth and Nationality.

Both players of a team must sign-in for Doubles.

- On-line (not available)
- Telephone or On site

Players may sign-in by phone or on-site. Both players in a team must sign-in.

The telephone and on-site sign-in usually opens in the afternoon the day before the sign-in deadline and closes at 12.00 local time the first day of the Singles Main Draw.

Entered players who preserve eligibility for the Main Draw during the Qualifying sign-in and who were moved to the Singles Main Draw must also sign-in at this time.

• Consolation Draw (24 players) – Mandatory to sign-in

From Wednesday, March 06 to Saturday, March 09

The Bonus Draw (Consolation) Sign-in Deadline shall be 30 minutes after the conclusion of the last match, in which a potentially eligible player plays.

It's a Mandatory to sign-in.

The exact time shall be decided by the Supervisor and must be announced on the Player Notice Board.

There are no Wild Cards for Bonus Draw (Consolation) Draws.

- **Match format**

- **Singles Main Draw**

- Matches are played in best of three (3) tiebreak sets. No rest shall be allowed after the second set.

- **Qualifying**

- Two (2) Tiebreak sets and a Match Tiebreak (10 points) in place of a third set.

- **Doubles**

- Matches are played with two (2) tiebreak sets with NoAd-scoring and, if required, a 10-point Match Tiebreak. No rest shall be allowed after the second set.

- **Bonus Draw (Consolation)**

- Best of three (3) Short Sets.

- The first player/team who wins four games wins that set, provided there is a margin of two games over the opponent(s). If the score reaches four games all, a tie-break game shall be played.

- **No let Rules**

- The NoLet service rule will be in operation at all Tennis Europe Junior Tour tournaments in Singles and Doubles.

- **Order of Play**

- Due to many matches sites, the order of play will not be easier as you can imagine. Keep in mind that all your requests could be not realized every time.

- The order of play will be realized around 19:00.

- **Balls**

- Official balls in FactSheet (Babolat)

- 4 new balls per match – Ball change only from semi-finals in Single Main Draw.

Consolation Draws: 4 used balls.

- **Practice**

- You can book your practice court at players' desk.

- Player's 1st match: automatically booked from 07:45 to 08:15 (if matches start at 09:00)

- Player's 2nd match: automatically booked from 08:15 to 08:45 (if matches start at 09:00)

Officiating

Tournament director are making their best efforts to provide Chair Umpire for all main draw matches (singles and doubles)
